State Street Provisions



The Grafton Group is finally crossing the river. The owners of Harvard Square (and nearby) restaurants Russell House Tavern, Grafton Street, PARK, and Temple Bar will open State Street Provisions in the former City Landing space by the Aquarium this fall. "It'll be somewhat of a hybrid

of Russell House and PARK," said co-owner Patrick Lee previously. "It has a little bit of both of those venues, and I think that space might take a little bit more from PARK, and maybe the menu might take a little bit more from Russell House." 255 State St., Boston (Downtown). **Opening Date:** Early November 2015.
